NARRATIVE

1. Describe the program/project and how it will address each of the grant objectives and key messages:

Grant objectives are (1) to increase awareness and support for transforming the local library, (2) to further the perception of the library as essential to the community and (3) to energize library advocates to influence local, state and national decision-makers. Key messages are (1) Libraries transform lives,

- (2) Libraries transform communities, (3) Libraries are community centers for lifelong learning and
- (4) Libraries are a smart investment.

The Outdoor Children's Garden has been in the works for about a decade. A smaller scale idea was originally included in the Board Strategic plan with the intent of creating a more welcoming space outside of the library building. Since then, ideas have grown in scope and scale to create an immersive environment with a focus on music literacy, education, interactivity and social gathering that will become a public park and part of the city's park system. The pandemic has also created increased pressure to create outdoor spaces that complement existing learning programs.

The project includes a variety of items that are themed around Roberto Burle Marx, a world famous landscape architect. It includes cabanas with picnic tables, interactive music literacy with large, outdoor musical instruments, a performance area for library programs, play area and an interactive splash pad.

As far as the grant objectives go, this project is a perfect fit for the grant.

It will increase awareness and support by attracting a different audience and developing unused existing space. With splash pads and outdoor areas in such high demand in Derby and the surrounding communities, it will continue to reinforce that the library is essential to the community. Local advocates and state officials have already become excited about the project. This will further energize them and allow them to attend grand opening and ground breaking events. This has been added to the Parks Master plan and has been met with positive response on social media.

This area clearly reflects the key messages of the grant. Helping children and families learn about architecture and music will change lives and create new opportunities. The community will be transformed with the addition of a new learning and play space. With the tropical and whimsical theme, the imagination of visitors will be stimulated. As a unique space, visitors from inside and outside the community will have the opportunity to interact with the library in a different way.

Reinforcing the idea of the library as a center for lifelong learning is another benefit of this project. The library already has an indoor early literacy area focusing on reading development; the outdoor children's garden will create a music literacy area and the opportunity for all ages to learn about landscape architecture. This unique and imaginative park will also emphasize the importance of libraries as a quality of life investment in the local community.

We hope to use SCKLS grant funds to enhance the splash pad portion of the project. The original design calls for fountains on a turf surface. Based on the community feedback we have received, we would like to change this to create a more interactive splash pad. This will come at an additional cost and an additional \$25,000 would be a big help in adding to this area.

The cost estimate from PEC puts the cost of the Slash pad at \$250,000. I have attached this project estimate for your reference. As I described earlier, I would like to use SCKLS grant funds to enhance this area.

Applicant must meet with the SCKLS Director prior to submitting grant application. The following conditions will be reviewed as part of the meeting:

If applicant is a school library, school library services must be administered by a licenses school library media specialist in compliance with Kansas Administrative Regulation 91-31-32(c) (9) (e) Library Services.

The minimum amount of matching grant request is \$5,000 and the maximum amount is \$25,000.

The primary purpose and costs associated with this grant application cannot be for projects or programs to repair or maintain for roof, heating/ventilation, electrical or other building infrastructure. A factor in determining grant eligibility is whether the proposed project or program will fully meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility guidelines.

The costs identified in this grant application cannot not/will not be duplicated in the applicant's other program/project funding or in applications for other SCKLS grant programs during 2024.

Award of the Libraries Transform Grant does not exclude an applicant member library from eligibility for other SCKLS grants subject to respective SCKLS grant guidelines.

A member public, academic, school district or special library that has previously been awarded a Libraries Transform Grant is ineligible for re-application for a seven year period from the date of original grant award.

Application does not guarantee award. SCKLS reserves the right to not award or to partially award any application. Award may vary depending on the availability of grant funds from SCKLS and upon number and amounts of qualified grant applications from member libraries.
