Conceptual thinking is abstract thinking - making connections and understanding what cannot be seen.



Comprehension

- Background Knowledge Conceptual Thinking
- Object permanence
- Cause and effect
- Identify characteristics/classify
- Sequencing
- Sense of time
- Problem solving
- Symbolic thinking





Content knowledge gives children a strong basis for later being able to understand what they will read.

Positive interactions around the book lead children to enjoy books and reading.




